Summer Fun Charters and Tours Ltd. Terms and Conditions

1. Reservations and payments

All rates are posted in Canadian dollars. Taxes, gratuities and fishing licences (if required) are not included in the rates. There is a link on our homepage to the DFO where you can acquire your fishing licence (for prawn fishing).

We prefer payment by e-transfer to <u>aapisto@shaw.ca</u>. We also accept VISA and MasterCard.

A deposit of 25% of the booking is required on booking. Full payment is required at least 3 days before the date of your charter.

2. Cancellations

If you cancel your scheduled charter more than 15 days in advance then you will be issued a refund less a \$50 processing fee.

If you cancel from 3 to 14 days in advance of your scheduled charter then you will be issued a refund of 50% of your deposit and 50% of your deposit will be retained. Note: Subject to availability if you rebook before the end of the current year's season (September 30) then the non-refundable deposit amount, less a \$50.00 processing fee, will be applied to the cost of the rebooked charter.

If you cancel your charter within either of the two days before your charter then your deposit will be retained. Note: Subject to availability if you rebook before the end of the current year's season (September 30) then the non-refundable deposit amount, less a \$50.00 processing fee, will be applied to the cost of the rebooked charter.

Once a charter starts no refund is issued if you ask that it end early for any reason (for example sea sickness or a desire to return early).

If there is a cancellation due to mechanical reasons a full refund will be issued.

All charters depart rain or shine. However if the boat operator determines, at his sole discretion, that the seas are unsafe or that there are dangerous weather conditions then the charter will be cancelled. In this circumstance a full refund will be issued or an alternate time or date will be agreed upon, your choice.

If the operator determines, at his sole discretion, during a charter that conditions have deteriorated to the extent that the charter must be shortened then a partial refund will be issued.

3. Departures

Excursions will depart from a marina that best fits the tour.

4. Safety and Behaviour

BEING IN A BOAT ON THE OCEAN IS INHERENTLY DANGEROUS. YOU ASSUME ALL RISKS OF INJURY OR WORSE.

Use of alcohol or illegal drugs or non-prescribed drugs is prohibited. If passengers behave in a disruptive, disorderly or unruly fashion then the operator of the charter will return to the harbour early and no refund will be issued.

Pets are not allowed.

We recommend that all of our guests wear personal flotation devices (PFD), which will be made available. If you can't swim then wear a PFD.

All children (under 19) must be accompanied by an adult and wear a PFD.
